

TOWN TROLLEY SERVICE Get across town with stops at Snowcreek Athletic Club, Minaret Village Shopping Center, The Village, Canyon Lodge and Juniper Springs Resort every 20 minutes. The open-air Lakes Basin Trolley leaves The Village for the Mammoth Lakes Basin every 30 minutes, stopping at most of the lakes in the Mammoth Lakes Basin and providing access to area hiking trails. Also tows a 14-bike trailer for access to cycling.

WELCOME ABOARD! The Mammoth Transit summer system operates from May 28 through November 19, 2021 and offers a convenient, fun and friendly alternative to getting around Mammoth Lakes. Passengers ride for free on all fixed routes in town. The Dial-A-Ride service requires a fare and is available to all riders, with priority given to special needs passengers.

VILLAGE TRANSPORTATION HUB The Town Trolley, Mammoth Bike Park Shuttle, Lakes Basin Trolley and the Purple Line all connect at The Village.

REDS MEADOW AND DEVILS POSTPILE NATIONAL MONUMENT Visitors to Reds Meadow and Devils Postpile this summer can begin their adventure from The Village. The shuttle is expected to operate from June 25 through September 6, 2021. The shuttle provides a convenient option for guests with service from The Village (Canyon Blvd. stop) every 45-60 minutes beginning at 7:15 AM with the last bus departing The Village (Canyon Blvd. stop) at 4:30 PM. The Reds Meadow Shuttle operates from the Adventure Center near Mammoth Mountain's Main Lodge from 7:30 AM until 6:15 PM with service every 20 minutes from 10 AM until 4 PM. Fare is \$15 for adults, \$7 for children (infants under two are free) and include a temporary increase in rates for calendar year 2021. Tickets can be purchased by reservation, in advance at www.MammothMountain.com/RedsMeadow, or by calling 1-800-MAMMOTH. Tickets may also be purchased from the Mammoth Adventure Center or after hours from the driver with exact change. Passengers returning to The Village can either ride the complimentary Bike Park Shuttle from the Main Lodge (last bus departs 5:10 PM), or catch the Reds Meadow Shuttle to The Village (last bus departs Reds Meadow at 7 PM).

DOGS are a fun part of Mammoth Lakes' mountain environment and are permitted on the Mammoth Transit Systems. For the safety and peace of mind of all passengers, dogs must be leashed and muzzled, or carried in a cage.

MAMMOTH BIKE PARK SHUTTLE The Mammoth Bike Park Shuttle is operated by Mammoth Mountain Ski Area for access to the Mammoth Bike Park and the Adventure Center near Main Lodge. Pedestrians may ride free, while a valid bike park ticket or pass is required to transport bicycles. Priority is given to bike park ticket and pass holders.

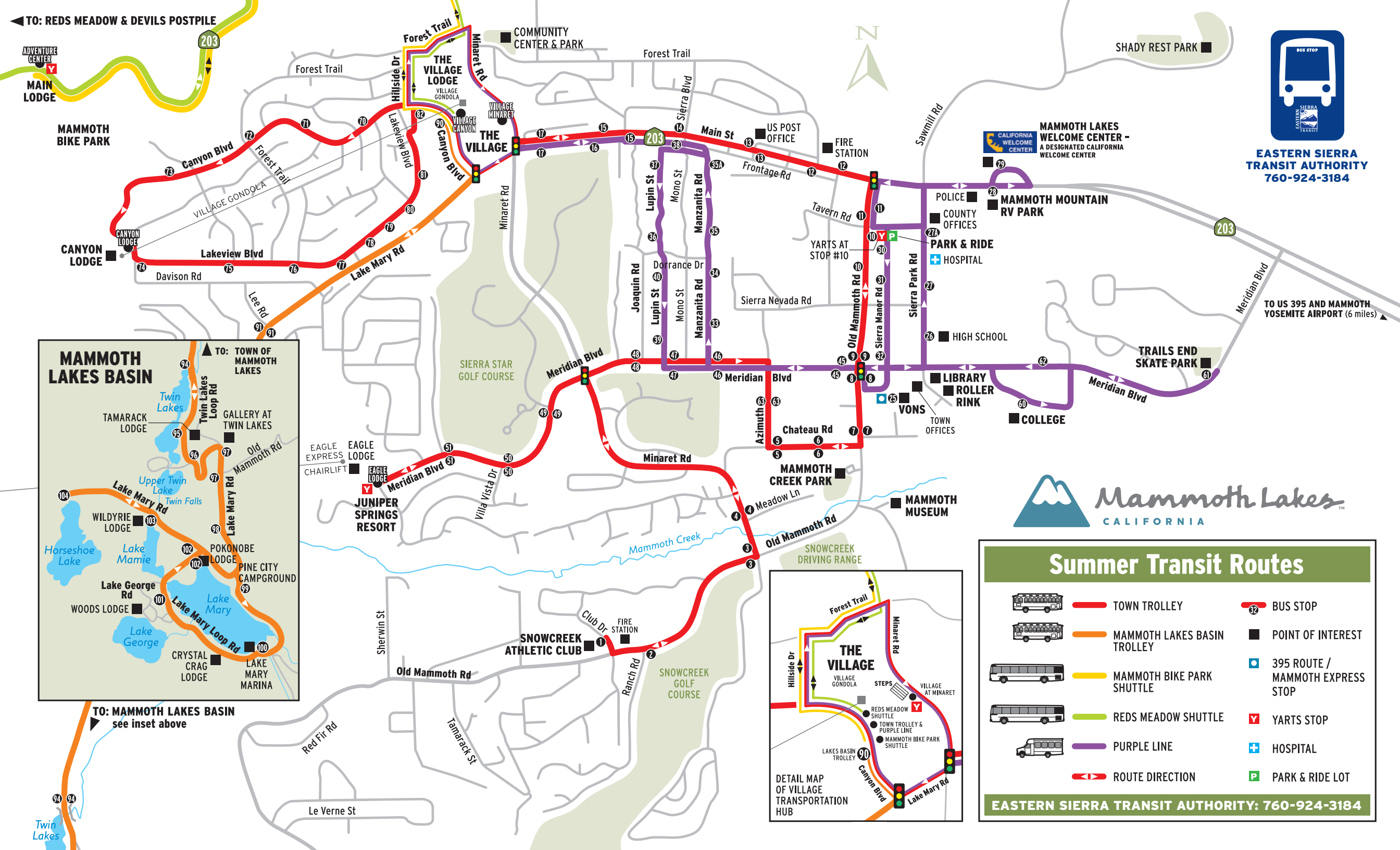

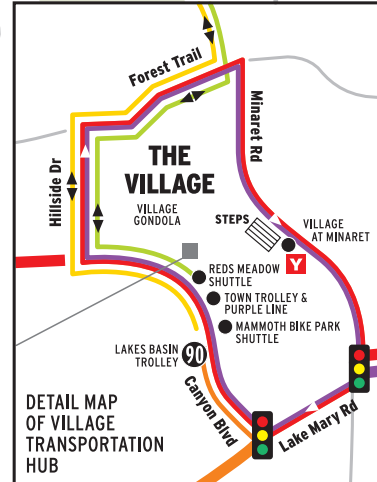
