VILLAGE TRANSPORTATION HUB The Town Trolley, Mammoth Bike Park Shuttle, Lakes Basin Trolley and the Purple Line all connect at The Village.

REDS MEADOW AND DEVILS POSTPILE NATIONAL MONUMENT

Visitors to Reds Meadow and Devils Postpile this summer can begin their adventure from The Village. The shuttle is expected to operate from June 25 through September 6, 2021. The shuttle provides a convenient option for guests with service from The Village (Canyon Blvd. stop) every 45-60 minutes beginning at 7:15 AM with the last bus departing The Village (Canyon Blvd. stop) at 4:30 pm. The Reds Meadow Shuttle operates from the Adventure Center near Mammoth Mountain's Main Lodge from 7:30 AM until 6:15 PM with service every 20 minutes from 10 AM until 4 PM. Fare is \$15 for adults, \$7 for children (infants under two are free) and include a temporary increase in rates for calendar year 2021. Tickets may also be purchased from the Mammoth Adventure Center or after hours from the driver with exact change. Passengers returning to The Village can either ride the complimentary Bike Park Shuttle from the Main Lodge (last bus departs 5:10 PM), or catch the Reds Meadow Shuttle to The Village (last bus departs Reds Meadow at 7 PM).
